EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: PHILLIPS HEAD SCREW DRIVER

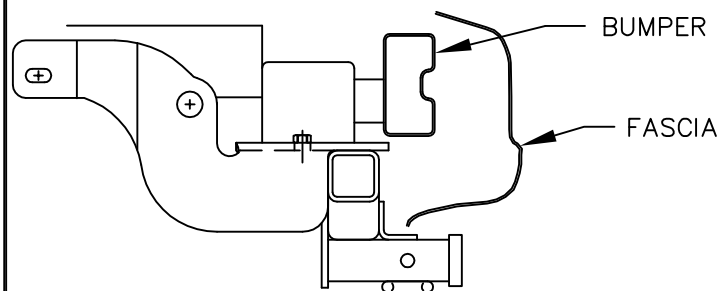
WIRING ACCESS LOCATION: SUV1, SUV2

DRILL BITS: NONE

HITCH REQUIRES 1/2" PIN AND CLIP

WRENCHES: (TIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS WITH TORQUE WRENCH) 10mm, 19mm

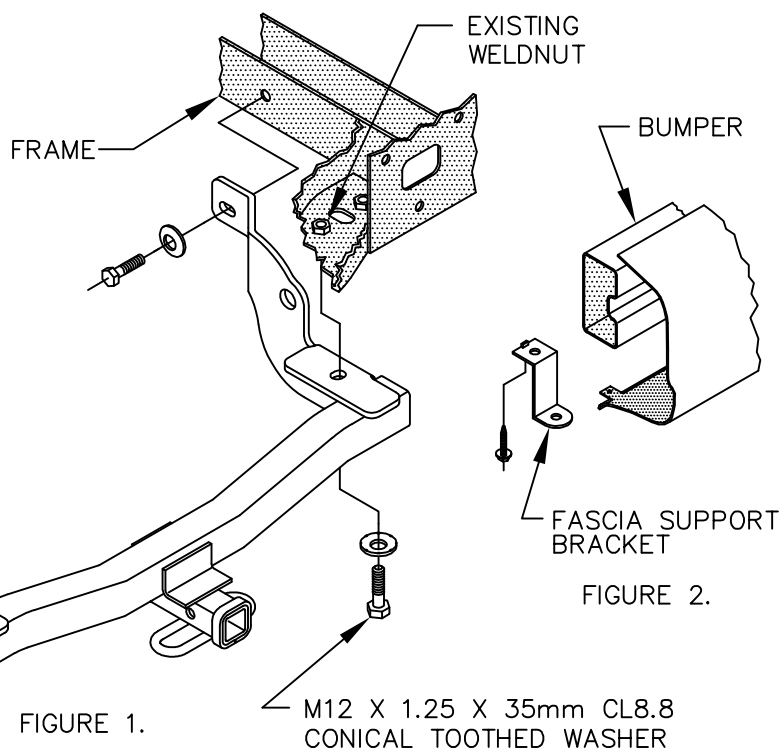
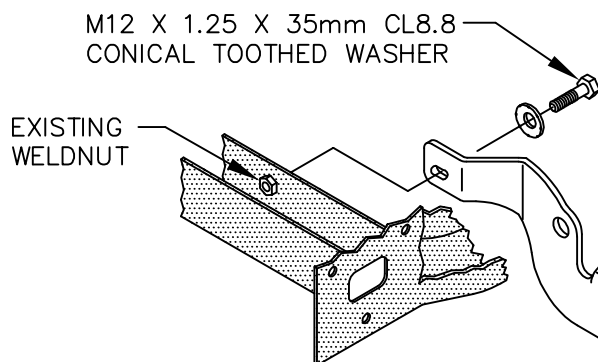
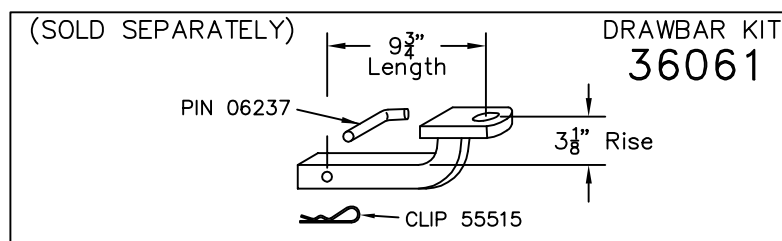

1. REMOVE THE (2) TWO FASCIA SUPPORT BRACKETS AND RETURN TO VEHICLE OWNER. (SEE FIGURE 2.)
2. LOWER VEHICLE EXHAUST.
3. RAISE HITCH INTO POSITION AND INSTALL FASTENERS AS SHOWN ABOVE. (SEE FIGURE 1.)
4. REATTACH VEHICLE EXHAUST LOWERED IN STEP 2.

TIGHTEN ALL M12 CL8.8 FASTENERS TO 68 LB.-FT



USE ONLY THE DRAWBAR SHOWN FOR CORRECT BUMPER CLEARANCE AND HEIGHT.
DRAWBAR MUST BE USED IN THE RISE POSITION ONLY.

If hitch is removed, plug all holes in trunk pan or other body panels to prevent entry of water and exhaust fumes. A hitch or ball which has been damaged should be removed and replaced. Observe safety precautions when working beneath a vehicle and wear eye protection. Follow car maker's specs for maximum trailer weight and tongue weight. Do not cut access or attachment holes with a torch.
