DRILL BITS: NONE


HITCH REQUIRES 5/8" PIN &amp; CLIP IF STABILIZING PIN IS NOT INSTALLED.

WRENCHES: (TIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS WITH TORQUE WRENCH) 18mm




1. ON 1998 AND LATER VEHICLES REMOVE THE (2) REARMOST RUBBER EXHAUST HANGERS AND LOWER VEHICLE EXHAUST.
2. RAISE HITCH INTO POSITION AND INSTALL FASTENERS AS SHOWN ABOVE.  
NOTE: DUE TO VEHICLE VARIATION, EXHAUST HANGER BRACKET ON PASSENGER'S SIDE MAY NEED TO BE ADJUSTED TO ALLOW FASTENER INSTALLATION.
3. REATTACH VEHICLE EXHAUST IF LOWERED IN STEP 1.

TIGHTEN ALL M12 CL8.8 FASTENERS TO 68 LB.-FT

NOTE: Check hitch frequently, making sure all fasteners and ball are properly tightened. If hitch is removed, plug all holes in trunk pan or other body panels to prevent entry of water and exhaust fumes. A hitch or ball which has been damaged should be removed and replaced. Observe safety precautions when working beneath a vehicle and wear eye protection. Follow car maker's specs for maximum trailer weight and tongue weight. Do not cut access or attachment holes with a torch.
